17 AN ACT to Regulate the Use of Child
18 Restraint in Motor Vehicles.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §1368-B, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 405,
23 is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

24 §1368-B. Use of child restraint devices

25 1. Children under one year of age. When a child
26 under the age of one year is a passenger in a motor
27 vehicle, which is required by the United States
28 Department of Transportation to be equipped with seat
29 belts, the operator of the motor vehicle shall have
30 the child properly secured in a child safety seat
31 that meets the requirements set out in 49 Code of
32 Federal Regulations, Part 571.
