AN ACT to Allow State Championship
Athletic Teams and Athletes the Right to
Participate in New England Championship
Events in Competition.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the State Principals' Association adopted a resolution on April 28, 1978, forbidding Maine's secondary school athletes from competing in New England championship events; and

Whereas, the right to compete in these championship events is an integral part of a student's educational opportunities; and
