Amend the bill in section 2, subsection 1 (page
2, line 5 in L.D.) by adding at the end a new sen-
tence to read:

'The fee for an investigative assistant's license is
\$300, of which \$100 must be submitted with the appli-
cation and \$200 must be submitted upon issuance of
the license.'

The purpose of this amendment is to add a provi-
sion for a \$300 fee for an investigative assistant's
license. A fee provision for an assistant's license
was inadvertently omitted from Title 32, chapter 89,
when it was enacted in 1981 and again omitted from
the original version of L.D. 1005.
