- 1. Amount. The fee for an original license is \$\frac{\pmathcal{4}\pmathcal{1}\pmathcal{0}}{200}\$, of which \$\frac{\pmathcal{2}}{25}\$ \$\frac{\pmathcal{5}\pmathcal{0}}{200}\$, must be submitted with the application and \$\frac{\pmathcal{7}}{5}\$ \$\frac{\pmathcal{5}\pmathcal{0}}{200}\$ must be submitted upon issuance of the license. The fee for a renewal is \$\frac{\pmathcal{5}}{5}\$ \$\frac{\pmathcal{0}}{200}\$, which is refundable upon denial of renewal.

- 8 Application; fee. Applications for original 9 licenses shall be made to the commissioner on forms 10 prescribed by him with respect to the requirements of 11 section 9405.
