17 AN ACT to Amend the Laws Relating to Fees  
18 for Private Investigator and Security Guard  
19 Licenses.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §8110, sub-§2, as enacted by PL  
24 1981, c. 126, §2, is amended to read:

25 2. Application. Application for an investigative  
26 assistant's license shall be made to the commissioner  
27 in accordance with the requirements of ~~section~~ sec-  
28 tions 8105 and 8107. The application shall be accom-  
29 panied by the fee required under section 8117.

30 Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §8117, sub-§1, as enacted by PL  
31 1981, c. 126, §2, is amended to read:

1           1. Amount. The fee for an original license is  
2   ~~\$100~~ \$200, of which ~~\$25~~ \$50 must be submitted with  
3   the application and ~~\$75~~ \$150 must be submitted upon  
4   issuance of the license. The fee for a renewal is ~~\$50~~  
5   \$100, which is refundable upon denial of renewal.

6           Sec. 3. 32 MRSA §9407, sub-§1, as enacted by PL  
7   1981, c. 113, §2, is amended to read:

8           1. Application; fee. Applications for original  
9   licenses shall be made to the commissioner on forms  
10  prescribed by him with respect to the requirements of  
11  section 9405. The fee for a license application is  
12  ~~\$200~~ \$400, of which ~~\$50~~ \$100 must be submitted with  
13  the application and ~~\$150~~ \$300 must be submitted upon  
14  issuance of the license. If the previously issued li-  
15  cense has expired and has not been renewed within a  
16  period of 60 days, the application shall be consid-  
17  ered the original application and the same fees and  
18  all requirements of an original application shall  
19  apply.

20           Sec. 4. 32 MRSA §9408, as enacted by PL 1981, c.  
21  113, §2, is amended to read:

22   §9408. Renewal of license

23           Each contract security company license shall be  
24  issued for a term of one year and is, unless revoked  
25  or suspended, renewable annually. The fee for a li-  
26  cense renewal is ~~\$100~~ \$200, which is refundable upon  
27  denial of renewal.

28                                 STATEMENT OF FACT

29           The intent of this bill is to increase the li-  
30  cense fees for private investigators and security  
31  guards so that revenues generated by the program will  
32  adequately cover the costs of administering it.
