SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 342, L.D. 1016, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish New Selection Procedures for the Maine Indian Tribal-State Commission Chairmanship."

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the following abbreviation and figure: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall not be effective unless, within 60 days of the adjournment of the Legislature, the Secretary of State receives written certification by the Joint Tribal Council of the Passamaquoddy Tribe and the governor and council of the Penobscot Nation that the respective tribe and nation have agreed to the provisions of this Act pursuant to the United States Code, Title 25, Section 1725(e) (1), copies of which shall be submitted by the Secretary of State to the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House; provided that in no event may this Act become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'
