HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 342, L.D. 1016,
Bill, "AN ACT to Establish New Selection Procedures
for the Maine Indian Tribal-State Commission Chair-
manship."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of
the first line after the enacting clause (page 1,
line 23 in L.D.) the abbreviation and figure
'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end
before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall be
effective only upon receipt by the Secretary of State
of written approval by the Passamaquoddy Tribe and
Penobscot Nation to the amendments to the Maine
Indian Land Claims Settlement Act, Public Law 1979,
chapter 733, sections 1, 30 and 31, provided that
that approval is received within 60 days after ad-
journment of the Legislature, and further provided,
that in no event may this Act become effective until
90 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'
