This Act shall be effective only upon receipt by the Secretary of State of written approval by the Passamaquoddy Tribe and Penobscot Nation to the amendments to the Maine Indian Land Claims Settlement Act, Public Law 1979, chapter 733, sections 1, 30 and 31, provided that that approval is received within 60 days after adjournment of the Legislature, and further provided, that in no event may this Act become effective until 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'
