3 STATE OF MAINE 4 SENATE 5 111TH LEGISLATURE 6 FIRST REGULAR SESSION COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to 7 S.P. 345, L.D. 1019, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit the Public Utili-ties Commission to Authorize a Management Audit of a 8 9 10 Public Utility." 11 Amend the bill in that part designated "§18." in the first sentence (page 1, lines 25 and 26 in L.D.) 12 13 by striking out the underlined words and punctuation "perform, or require the performance of," and insert-ing in their place the underlined words 'require the 14 15 16 17 performance of 18 Further amend the bill in that part designated 19 "<u>§18.</u>" by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph, (page 2, lines 12 to 23 in L.D.) and inserting in its 20 21 place the following: 'The commission shall have discretion to have a management audit performed by an independent auditor. 22 23 In the event that the commission finds it reasonable and necessary to have the audit performed, it may select the independent auditor, require a public utility to pay for the costs of a management audit of 24 25 26 27 28 its operations and require the public utility to 29 execute a contract with the independent auditor. 30 Further amend the bill in that part designated " $\underline{\$18.}$ " by striking out all of the last paragraph before the statement of fact (page 2, lines 24 to 27 31 32 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 33 34 'The full cost of the management audit shall be 35 recovered from ratepayers. In ordering an audit, the commission shall consider the impact of the cost of 36 the audit upon ratepayers and other alternatives that 37
