21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 21 MRS A §1395-A is enacted to read:

24 §1395-A. Campaign spending limits on state legis-
25 lative elections

26 No candidate for an elective state legislative
27 office may exceed the campaign spending limits set
28 out in this section. Campaign spending limits for
29 primary and general elections for House and Senate
30 candidates are as follows:

31 1. House candidates. Primary and general elec-
32 tions for the House: \$1,500 for each; and
