STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to mandate a state-6 wide pretrial release and service mechanism which 7 will ensure that all people charged with criminal 8 offenses will be interviewed before arraignment in 9 order to determine and verify the information neces-10 11 sary for the courts to make an informed decision in the setting of bail. This bill will serve the fur-12 ther purpose of alleviating the overcrowded condi-13 tions of Maine's county jails by providing a mecha-14 15 nism that could recommend pretrial diversion to 16 appropriate community 3rd-party custodial care facil-17 ities and programs.

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
