1 the tolls, such those tolls to be reimbursed where 2 Legislators use the Maine Turnpike in traveling to 3 and from sessions of the Legislature or in perfor-4 mance of duly authorized committee assignments. Any 5 Legislator who resides more than 150 road miles from the Statehouse may, in lieu of payment for travel, be 6 7 reimbursed for airline fare to and from the airport 8 closest to his residence, plus mileage from that airport to his residence, at each legislative session 9 10 once each week. Each Legislator is entitled to mile-11 age on the first day of the session, and such amounts 12 of his salary and expenses at such times as the Legislature may determine during the session, and the 13 balance at the end thereof. 14

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that Legislators who live more than 150 miles from the Statehouse may be reimbursed for airline fare in lieu of mileage.
