He shall cause to have 5 published this explanatory statement in each daily 6 newspaper of the State, such statement to be pub-7 lished not more than 45 days and not less than 30 days prior to the voting and publish such statement 8 9 in each daily newspaper of the State a 2nd time, not 10 more than 10 and not less than 7 days prior to the 11 voting. STATEMENT OF FACT

18 The purpose of this bill is to require that the 19 explanations of all statewide referenda questions be 20 written clearly and that the explanation be posted in 21 all polling places and in all voting booths to assist 22 the voters in understanding the referenda questions.
