5. Reimbursement for additional professional
training. When a certified teacher completes, within
any 2-year period, 6 credit hours of additional pro-
fessional work approved by the superintendent, the
school administrative unit shall pay that teacher not
less than ~~\$100~~ \$260, or the actual tuition charge,
whichever is less, for teachers who are not covered
by collective bargaining contracts pursuant to Title
26, chapter 9-A.'
