2 3 4 5 5 7	This amendment reduces from 5 to 3 the period of years within which conviction of 5 violations results in a person coming under the definition of an habitual violator. After a license revocation for being an habitual violator, no license may be granted to that person for a period of 3 years. The verb tense change makes the language consistent.
