7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 357,
8 L.D. 1078, Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to License Revo-
9 cation Notices Issued by the Commissioner of Inland
10 Fisheries and Wildlife."

11 Amend the bill in section 1 in the 6th line (page
12 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined
13 figure "5" and inserting in its place the underlined
14 figure '3'

15 Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part
16 designated "§7079." in subsection 1 in the 5th, 6th,
17 7th and 8th lines (page 2, lines 20 to 23 in L.D.) by
18 striking out the underlined punctuation and words
19 "person, including that person's privilege to obtain
20 any license or permit issued by the department, for a
21 period of 3 years" and inserting in their place the
22 following underlined punctuation and words 'person.
23 No license may be granted to that person for a period
24 of 3 years from the date of revocation'

25 Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part
26 designated "§7079." in subsection 2, paragraph A in
27 the 6th line (page 2, line 30 in L.D.) by striking
28 out the underlined word "be" and inserting in its
29 place the underlined words 'have been'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 357, L.D. 1078

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This amendment reduces from 5 to 3 the period of
3 years within which conviction of 5 violations results
4 in a person coming under the definition of an habit-
5 ual violator. After a license revocation for being
6 an habitual violator, no license may be granted to
7 that person for a period of 3 years. The verb tense
8 change makes the language consistent.
