HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 877, L.D. 1131,
Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Truancy Laws."

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph A in the
4th line (page 2, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out
the underlined letter "B" and inserting in its place
the underlined letter and number 'A-1'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in paragraph
B in the last line (page 2, line 18 in L.D.) by
striking out the stricken out word "~~or~~" and inserting
in its place the word 'or'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in paragraph
C in the last line (page 2, line 20 in L.D.) by
striking out the underlined punctuation and word ";
or" and inserting in its place the punctuation '.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of
section 3.

Further amend the Bill in section 4 in paragraph
A in subparagraph (1) in the last line (page 2, line
30 in L.D.) by striking out the stricken out word
"~~and~~" and inserting in its place the word 'and'

Further amend the Bill in section 4 in paragraph
A in subparagraph (2) in the last line (page 2, line
33 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined punctu-
ation and word ";
and" and inserting in their place
the punctuation '.'

Further amend the Bill in section 4 in paragraph
A by striking out all of subparagraph (3).

1 Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sec-
2 tions to read consecutively.

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This amendment removes the language from the bill
5 which would have made it an offense to be 14 years of
6 age or older and be an habitual truant. This amend-
7 ment also removes the penalty provision which would
8 have applied to that same class of individuals.
