Amend the Bill in section 4 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraph (1) and inserting in its place the following:

'(1) Subsection 1, paragraph A shall may be punished by a forfeiture of not more than \$200 \$25 and the court may order that the person perform a specified number of hours of community service. The court may waive imposition of a forfeiture and order the person to perform a specified number of hours of community service in lieu of the forfeiture; and'
