AN ACT to Allow the Training of Bear
Dogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §7861, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:

1. Open training season. Except as provided for in section 7331, it is lawful to train dogs on foxes, rabbits and raccoons from August 1st through the following April 30th. It is also lawful to train dogs on bears from August 1st through August 31st.
