To bring statutory provisions in line with 12 the current practice of the Secretary of State in ensuring the validity of all title transfers; 13 To incorporate in Title 29, section 14 3. 2377, subsection 4, grant of authority, the fee schedule 15 16 set forth in section 2352; 17 4.
