tion for submission to the electors only if they are so closely related to each other that one cannot be enacted or financed without the other or, in the case of bonds, if they are similar projects in different locations.

Questions submitted to the voters under this section shall be worded in an affirmative manner and shall be written as simply and clearly as possible. The Secretary of State shall review all questions submitted to the voters under this section and, if any question is not written in compliance with this section, he shall rewrite the question before submitting it to the voters.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to limit the combining of referenda issues and bond issue projects. The bill also requires that referenda or bond issue questions be written in an affirmative manner and be as simple and clear as possible.
