17 AN ACT to Increase Benefits under the
18 Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Act.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §6108, as amended by PL 1981, c.
23 698, §189, is further amended to read:

24 §6108. Income limitation

25 No claim otherwise allowable may be granted to
26 claimants of single member households with adjusted
27 household income in excess of \$5,600 in calendar year
28 1980 and \$6,200 in each succeeding year for which
29 relief is requested; and no claim otherwise allowable
30 may be granted to claimants of households of 2 or more
31 members with adjusted household income in excess of
32 \$6,700 in calendar year 1980 and \$7,400 in each suc-
33 ceeding year for which relief is requested.
