HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 913, L.D. 1166,
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Special Telecommunications
Equipment for the Deaf, Hearing Impaired and Speech
Impaired."

11 Amend the bill in section 2 in that part desig-12 nated "<u>§2361.</u>", subsection 3 by striking out all of 13 subsection 3 and inserting in its place the follow-14 ing:

'3. Telecommunications equipment fund. For cal-15 16 endar years 1983 through and including 1988, each telephone company, authorized to do business in this 17 18 State which provides service by means of a wire or 19 cable between the customers premise and a central 20 office exchange shall pay into a special Telecommuni-21 cations Equipment Fund an assessment based on its 22 intrastate gross operating revenues to produce no 23 more than \$40,000 in revenue annually. The commission shall determine the assessments annually prior 24 25 to May 1st and shall assess each company for its pro-26 rata share. Each company shall pay its assessment on 27 or before December 31st each year. The assessments charged under this section shall be deemed just and 28 29 reasonable operating costs for rate-making purposes. 30 For purposes of this section, intrastate gross operating revenues means intrastate revenues derived from 31 32 filed rates. The fund may be used for purchase, 33 lease, upgrading, installation, maintenance and 34 repair of special telecommunications equipment for the deaf, hearing impaired or speech impaired. The 35 Office of Deafness under the Bureau of Rehabilitation 36 may draw on the fund in accordance with the Telecom-37 38 munications Equipment Plan required under subsection 39 4. The commission shall include a progress report on

this program in its annual report under Title 35, 1 2 section 17, subsection 2. Further amend the bill by striking out all of 3 section 3 and inserting in its place the following: 4 'Sec. 3. Allocation. The following funds are 5 allocated from the Telecommunications Equipment Fund 6 to carry out the purposes of this Act. 7 8 1983-84 1984-85 Bureau of Rehabilitation 9 40,000' 10 OFFICE OF DEAFNESS \$40,000 STATEMENT OF FACT 11 12 This amendment removes the General Fund appropriation from the bill. 13

It creates a dedicated revenue fund from which 14 15 moneys can be taken by the Office of Deafness to pro-16 vide, upgrade and service special telecommunications 17 equipment used by deaf, hearing impaired, and speech imparied persons. The fund, \$40,000 per year for 1983 through 1988 will be supported by an assessment 18 19 20 the telephone companies. The fiscal impact of on 21 this bill is to a dedicated revenue fund.
