SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 913, L.D. 1166,

Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Special Telecommunications

Equipment for the Deaf, Hearing Impaired and Speech

Impaired."

Amend the Bill in section 1, in that part design-

12

ated "§2361." in subsection 1 by inserting at the

13

end after the word and punctuation "telephone." (page

14

2, line 11 in L.D.)the following: 'This rate reduc-

15

tion shall also apply on intrastate toll calls made

16

by the customer from a teletypewriter telephone and

17

charged to his residential number.

18

The commission shall establish a 35% rate reduction

19

for intrastate toll calls made from nonprofit agen-

20

cies which serve the hearing-impaired community. To

21

qualify for the reduction, an agency must annually

22

file an affidavit, on a form approved by the commis-

23

sion, with the telephone company stating their pur-

24

poses, clientele and information on their contracts

25

to serve the hearing-impaired community.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

27

The purpose of this amendment is to allow rate

28

reductions for hearing-impaired persons who make

29

calls from teletypewriter phones other than their


