3 STATE OF MAINE 4 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 5 111TH LEGISLATURE 6 FIRST REGULAR SESSION HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 915, L.D. 1168, 7 Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Municipal Regulation of 8 9 Motor Vehicles on Ice-covered Bodies of Water." 10 Amend the Bill by inserting after the enacting 11 clause the following: 12 'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §685-A, sub-§3, ¶F, as amended 13 by PL 1973, c. 569, §10, is further amended to read: Reflect a consideration of the availability 14 F. 15 and capability of the natural resources base, including soils, topography or sufficient health-16 17 ful water supplies; and 18 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §685-A, sub-§3, ¶G is enacted to 19 read: 20 G. Regulate, as necessary, motor vehicles as defined in Title 29, section 1, subsection 7, on 21 22 icebound inland lakes which are completely encom-23 passed by unorganized territories during the 24 hours from sunset to sunrise of the following 25 day. Sec. 3. 30 MRSA §1901, sub-§6, as amended by PL 26 27 1977, c. 390, §3, is further amended to read: 6. <u>Municipality.</u> "Municipality" includes only cities and towns, but shall include plantations in 28 29 chapter 239, subchapters V and VI and, for purposes 30 31 of regulating motor vehicles on icebound inland lakes pursuant to section 2151, subsection 7. 32 33 Further amend the Bill in section 1, in subsection 7, first paragraph, by striking out all of the 34

1 last underlined sentence (page 2, lines 3 to 5 in 2 L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

3 'A village corporation and a plantation shall have 4 the same powers and duties as a municipality under 5 this subsection. Motor vehicles on icebound inland lakes which are completely encompassed by unorganized 6 7 territories shall be regulated by the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission. Motor vehicles on icebound 8 inland lakes which are abutted by an unorganized ter-9 ritory and either one or more municipalities, village 10 11 corporations or plantations, in any combination, 12 shall be regulated by those municipalities, village 13 corporations or plantations, as provided in para-14 graphs A and B.

15 Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sections to 16 read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This amendment corrects an omission in the original draft by providing authority to plantations to 19 20 regulate motor vehicles on icebound inland lakes and, for lakes surrounded by unorganized territories, authority to the Maine Land Use Regulation Commis-21 22 Lakes surrounded by unorganized territories 23 sion. 24 and a municipality, village corporation or plantation 25 does not need regulation by the commission.
