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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 388, L.D. 1171,
Bill, "AN ACT to License the Harvest of Seaweeds."

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Amend the bill in section 3, in that part designated "§6802." by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 2, lines 6 to 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

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'2. Other licenses. The holder of a current marine worm dealer license, wholesale or retail seafood license, lobster and crab fishing license or shellfish license may engage in the activities authorized under this section.'

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Further amend the bill in section 3, in that part designated "§6802." by striking out all of subsections 4 and 5 (page 2, lines 14 to 21 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

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'4. Report. Each person who holds a seaweed permit shall report to the commissioner, by January 30th, the total amount of seaweed he has commercially harvested during the previous calender year.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment exempts holders of certain marine resource licenses from the requirement to obtain a seaweed permit. The amendment also removes the fees

1 for these permits and requires annual reporting of
2 seaweed harvests.
