## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 932, L.D. 1177

This amendment changes in section 2 the word "investigations" to "studies". It also removes reference to the right of parents to refuse consent, since this is covered elsewhere in state and federal law. The addition of a new section 3 removes a conflicting paragraph to the new paragraph E in Title 22, section 4008, subsection 3.
