11	2nd paragraph after the title and inserting in its
12	place the following:
13	'Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all
14	of paragraph A and inserting in its place the follow-
15	ing:
16	A. At least 90 days prior to the election to
17	which they pertain, the Secretary of State shall
18	furnish each municipality with a reasonable
19 20	number of blank absentee ballots for the exclusive use of members of the Armed Forces. These
21	ballots shall be similar to regular ballots,
22	except that no candidate names may be printed.
23	The Secretary of State shall prepare a ballot
24	listing all offices to be selected with spaces
25	after each office for the names of candidates for
26	that office and for writing in the name and
27 28	municipality of residence of any person whose
29	name is not on the ballot when it is received by the voter. The Secretary of State shall place a
30	voting box to the left of each space. The fol-
31	lowing instructions must be printed in bold type
32	at the top of the ballot: "YOU MAY VOTE FOR A
33	PERSON BY PLACING A MARK IN THE SQUARE AT THE
34	LEFT OF EACH CANDIDATE FOR WHOM YOU WISH TO VOTE
35	OR BY PLACING THAT PERSON'S NAME AND MUNICIPALITY
36	OF RESIDENCE IN THE BLANK SPACE UNDER THE PROPER
37	OFFICE AND MARKING THE SQUARE AT THE LEFT."

39	designated "§1306." by striking out all of the last 2

1	underlined sentences (page 3, lines 7 to 13 in L.D.)
2	and inserting in their place the following: 'The
3	applicant for the absentee ballot may request the
	regular absentee ballot specified in section 1252,
5	subsection 1, or the special ballot specified in
4 5 6	section 1252, subsection 1, paragraph A. When a spe-
7	cial ballot is requested, the clerk shall type in the
8	spaces after each office the names of all individuals
9	who have qualified as candidates for that office as
10	of that time, their party designation, if any, and
11	municipality of residence. The clerk shall promptly
12	fill requests for absentee ballots made under this
13	section.
14	STATEMENT OF FACT
15	The purpose of this amendment is to require that
16	when a special blank ballot is requested, the munici-

pal clerk types in the names of the candidates for each office who have qualified as of that time.
