23	Further amend the bill in section 6 by striking
24	out all of that part designated "§2448." and insert-

26	§2448. License required
27	No person may engage in business as a salvage vehicle dealer, recycler or as a repairer without
28 29	having been issued a license under this subchapter.
30	The terms of each license shall be for the period
31	beginning from the date of issuance of that license
32	and ending on the 31st day of December next follow-
33	ing.
34	A person is engaged in the business of salvage
35	vehicles, recycler or as a repairer when that person
36	is in the business of buying more than 5 salvage

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- vehicles within a 12-month period for the purpose of reselling component parts or rebuilding salvage vehi-cles for the purpose of resale, or permits the dis-2 3 play of salvage vehicles or parts thereof upon prem-4 ises owned or controlled by him. Failure to obtain 5 6 such a license is a Class E crime.
 - §2449. Exemptions

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- Financial institutions, as defined in Title 9-B, section 131, subsections 17 and 17-A, all insurance 10 companies licensed to do business in this State and persons performing repairs to vehicles registered in their names, as provided for in chapter 5, are exempt from this subchapter.
- Dealerships. Any business, duly licensed by 14 Secretary of State under chapter 5, subchapter 15 16 III-A, who also is engaged in the business as a salvage vehicle dealer, recycler or as a repairer, as part of his dealership shall be exempt from the 17 18 licensing provision of section 2448. 19
 - 2. Retail businesses selling primarily new or rebuilt auto parts. Retail businesses that sell primarily new auto parts or rebuilt auto parts that do not buy salvage vehicles to dismantle for their inventories shall be exempt from the licensing provision of section 2448.
 - Further amend the bill in section 6 in that part designated "§2449." in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the last line (page 5, line 18 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word and punctuation "handled;" and inserting in its place the underlined words and punctuation 'handled; and'
 - Further amend the bill in section 6 in that part designated "§2449." in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the last line (page 5, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined punctuation and word "; and" and inserting in their place the underlined punctuation

8 9 .0	'The records and the established place of business shall at all times be available for inspection by the Secretary of State, his duly authorized agents or the Chief of the State Police or his designee.'
12 13 14	Further amend the bill in section 6 in that part designated " $\S2458$." by inserting before the last paragraph the following:
15 16 17 18 19	'The records and the established place of business shall at all times be available for inspection by the Secretary of State, his duly authorized agent or the Chief of the State Police or his designee.' Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.
21	STATEMENT OF FACT
22 23 24 25 26 27	This amendment modifies and clarifies the title and anti-theft provisions of the motor vehicle laws to provide for the licensing and regulation of persons engaged in business as recyclers and scrap processors. Assumption of these functions by the Secretary of State will help ensure establishment and

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- assistance of a clear chain of ownership of motor vehicles and eliminate opportunities for illegal ac-1
- 3 tivities.
