17 AN ACT Concerning Insurance Rates for
18 Persons with Good Driving Records.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 24-A MRSA §2908 is enacted to read:

23 §2908. Reduction in premiums for good driving record

24 No insurance company authorized to transact busi-
25 ness in this State may issue any automobile insurance
26 policy, unless that policy contains a provision pro-
27 viding for the reduction in premiums for that policy
28 if the insured maintains a good driving record for a
29 period of time not to exceed 3 years. The policy
30 shall provide that the premium reduction shall be
31 comparable to premium increases charged by that com-
32 pany for individuals who have poor driving records.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that automobile insurers provide premium reductions for persons who maintain good driving records. This will help to encourage good driving habits.

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
