The term of each appointed member shall be 5 years or until his successor is appointed and qualified. Of the members first appointed, 3 shall be for one year, 3 for 2 years, 3 for 3 years, 3 for 4 years and 3 for years. Subsequent appointments shall be for the full term of 5 years. No members shall serve more than 2 successive terms. In the case of a vacancy other than the expiration of a term, the appointment of a successor shall be made in like manner for the balance of the term.

In addition to the 15 appointed members, the direc-15 16 tors of the area reference and resource centers shall 17 serve as permanent, nonvoting ex officio members of 18 the Maine Library Commission.

19 The commission shall meet at least 4 times a year. It shall elect a chairman for a term of 2 years 20 21 frame and modify bylaws for its internal organization 22 and operation. The State Librarian shall serve as secretary to the commission. The members of the com-23 24 mission shall serve without compensation, but 25 be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. 26

STATEMENT OF FACT

Representation from the directors of the reference and resource centers is vital if the Maine Library Commission is to perform its proper The commission advises the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services regarding the operation of the regional library system. The system is structured around the 3 area reference and resource centers located at the Maine State Library and the Bangor and Portland public libraries. The operation of the system is often inseparable from the operation of the area reference and resource centers. The area reference and resource center directors provide the

commission with valuable advice and direction from which decisions regarding the performance of the regional system are made. The nonvoting ex officio status for the area reference and resource center directors would allow them to contribute continous input into the decision-making process without being part of it, i.e., a voting member whose term will eventually expire.
