Any person who willfully violates any 14 provision of this section shall be punished by a fine 15 of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500, or by 16 imprisonment for not more than 90 days for each 17 offense, or by both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

19 The purpose of this bill is to permit the inspec-20 tion of hotel and lodging house records by duly 21 authorized local police officers as well as by state 22 police officers.

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
