HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 928, L.D. 1207,
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Menhaden Fishing in Casco
Bay."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§6572."
by striking out all of the first underlined paragraph
(page 1, lines 24 to 28 in L.D.) and inserting in its
place the following:

'It is unlawful to fish for or take menhaden by
purse or stop seine without a permit from the Depart-
ment of Marine Resources in the area of Casco Bay in
Cumberland County beginning at the southern tip of
West Cundy Point westerly to the navigational buoy N
"4"; then continuing southwesterly to the northern
tip of Ram Island; then continuing southwesterly to
and along the eastern shore of Jaquish Island to its
southern tip; then westerly to the navigational buoy
R "2"; continuing westerly to the navigational buoy N
"4"; then continuing northwesterly to the
navigational buoy C "3"; then continuing northerly to
the navigational buoy RBN; then continuing northerly
to the navigational gong BR south of Whaleboat Is-
land; then continuing northerly to the eastern tip of
Upper Green Island; then continuing easterly to and
along the northern shore of Little Whaleboat Island;
then continuing easterly to the northwestern tip of
Curtis Cove on Harpswell Neck. This shall include
all the waters of Quahog Bay, Merriconeag Sound and
Harpswell Sound. In addition, it is unlawful to fish
for or take menhaden by purse or stop seine in the
area of the New Meadows River, north of a line from
the southern most tip of Foster Point, westerly to
the northern most tip of Indian Point.'
