11 12	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
13 14 15	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
16 17 18	Whereas, this Act is essential to effective enforcement of handicapped parking zones designated at service areas on the Maine Turnpike; and
19 20	Whereas, the busy season for Maine Turnpike traffic is quickly approaching; and
21 22 23 24 25 26	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
27 28	Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:
29 30	'Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §2151, sub-§2, ¶K, as amended by PL 1983, c. 133, is further amended to read:
31 32 33 34	K. Providing for the establishment and policing of parking spaces designated for handicapped per- sons. A municipality with off-street public parking areas may set aside an adequate number of

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these spaces for use by handicapped persons. municipality with on-street public parking spaces may set aside an adequate number of these spaces locations for use by handicapped in appropriate persons. The municipality may post any of the signs authorized by this paragraph adjacent to and visible from each handicapped parking space. One sign shall consist of a profile view of a wheelchair with an occupant in white on a blue background with a printed inscription. The inscription shall read: "Handicapped Parking: Special Plate Required. Unauthorized vehicles are subject to a fine." The other signs authorized under this paragraph and which may be posted in lieu of the first sign shall consist of a profile view of a wheelchair with an occupant in white on a blue background which may bear an inscription. Any new sign erected or any sign replaced after the effective date of this paragraph shall conform to the signs authorized by this paragraph. Any existing posted signs that do not conform to the provisions of this paragraph and which were erected prior to the effective date of this paragraph shall be deemed to be valid for enforcement purposes. Any vehicle parked in a parking space designated by a municipality as a handicapped parking space that does not bear a special registration plate or placard issued under Title 29, section 252, or a similar plate issued by another state, shall be cited for a penalty not to exceed \$25 unless otherwise established by local ordinance. Owners of private off-street parking may enter into agreements with local or county law enforcement agencies for the policing of stalls and spaces dedicated for handicapped persons' vehicles, under which agreements unauthorized vehicles shall be Where service facilities are established on the Maine Turnpike and on the interstate highway system in Maine, the State Police shall enforce this subsection.

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1 2	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
3 4 5	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

7 8 9	This amendment simply changes the statutory reference in section 2 to reflect enactment of Legislative Document 728.
