STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE

AN ACT to Make Allocations from the Low-level Waste Siting Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1984, and June 30, 1985.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period will not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the Low-level Waste Siting Commission will become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1983; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
4 therefore,

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 Allocation of the Low-level Waste Siting Fund.
8 Income to the Low-level Waste Siting Fund for the
9 next 2 fiscal years, from July 1, 1983, to June 30,
10 1984, and from July 1, 1984, to June 30, 1985, shall
11 be segregated, apportioned and disbursed as desig-
12 nated in the following schedule.

14	<u>Low-level Waste Siting Commission</u>		
15	All Other	\$4,860	\$5,248

16 This allocates the
17 Low-level Waste Siting
18 Fund which is required
19 by Public Law 1981,
20 chapter 439.

21 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited
22 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect July 1,
23 1983.

25 The purpose of this bill is reflected in the
26 emergency preamble.
