17 AN ACT to Ban Metal-Piercing
18 Ammunition.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 17-A MRSA §1056 is enacted to read:

23 §1056. Trafficking in metal-piercing ammunition.

24 1. A person is guilty of trafficking in
25 metal-piercing ammunition if he knowingly manufac-
26 tures, imports, sells, offers to sell, displays,
27 lends, gives away, possesses or purchases that ammu-
28 nition.

29 2. As used in this chapter "metal-piercing ammu-
30 nition" means any type of ammunition, or any
31 projectile component thereof, which is coated with
32 polytetrafluoroethylene or any other similar coating
33 which is designed primarily to enhance its capability
34 to penetrate metal or pierce protective armor.
