and adjustments, payment of debts and liabilities incurred in construction and reconstruction of highways and bridges, the cost of construction, reconstruction, maintenance and repair of public highways and bridges under the direction and supervision of a state department having jurisdiction over such highways and bridges and, expense for state enforcement of traffic laws and for operational subsidies for various forms of surface passenger transit and shall not be diverted for any purpose, provided that these limitations shall not apply to revenue from an excise tax on motor vehicles imposed in lieu of personal property tax.

Constitutional referendum procedure; form question; effective date. Resolved: That the city aldermen, town selectmen and plantation assessors of this State shall notify the inhabitants οf their respective cities, towns and plantations to meet, in the manner prescribed by law for holding a statewide election, at a statewide election, on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November following passage of this resolution, to vote upon the ratification of the amendment proposed in this resolution by voting upon the following question:

"Shall the Constitution of Maine be amended to permit dedicated revenues from the Highway Fund to be used to provide operating subsidies for various forms of surface passenger transit, such as buses, trains and ferries?"

town The legal voters of each city, and plantation shall vote by ballot on this question, and shall designate their choice by a cross or check mark placed within the corresponding square below the word "No." or The ballots shall be received, sorted, counted and declared in open ward, town and plantation meetings and returns made to the Secretary State in the same manner as votes for members of the Legislature. The Governor shall review the returns and, if it appears that a majority of the legal votes are in favor of the amendment, the Governor shall proclaim that fact without delay and amendment shall become part of the Constitution on the date of the proclamation.

Secretary of State shall prepare ballots. Resolved: That the Secretary of State shall prepare and furnish to each city, town and plantation all ballots, returns and copies of this resolution necessary to carry out the purposes of this referendum.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this constitutional resolution is to permit dedicated revenues from the Highway Fund to be used to provide operating subsidies for various forms of surface passenger transportation, such as buses, trains and ferries. If this resolution is adopted, it is expected that in future years other revenue sources will be tapped to provide the funds to the Highway Fund from which these subsidies will come.
