**RESOLVE, Reimbursing Certain Municipalities
on Account of Taxes Lost Due to Lands being
Classified under the Tree Growth
Tax Law.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, certain municipalities have been reimbursed 75% of the tax loss pursuant to the Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 578, and there remains moneys due these municipalities; and

Whereas, certain municipalities currently need the remaining reimbursement funds due to the taxes lost; and

10 municipal valuation returns in time to be included in
11 this resolve, or the 20 municipalities which did not
12 achieve the appropriate minimum assessment ratio de-
13 scribed in Title 36, section 327.
