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wage established under this section shall increased to the same amount, effective on the same date as the increase in the highest federal minimum wage, but in no case shall may the minimum wage exceed \$4 per hour. The overtime provision of this section shall not apply to seamen, the canning, processing, preserving, freezing, drying, marketing, shipment or distribution of storing, packing for herring as sardines, of perishable foods, of agricultural produce and meat and fish products, nor to the 10 canning of perishable goods, nor to hotels, motels, restaurants and other eating establishments, nor to 13 public employees, except that the overtime provision shall apply to individuals performing services for an 14 15 agricultural enterprise who are not exempt employees 16 under section 663, subsection 3, paragraph A.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to insure that the overtime provisions of Title 26, section 664 more closely match the minimum wage provisions of section 663. Under this bill, employees of an agricultural enterprise who are not exempt from the general coverage of the law under section 663, subsection 3, will also be covered under the overtime provisions section 664.

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
