## STATEMENT OF FACT

 The bill removes the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission over dealers who sell liquid gas in individual containers or who sell gas from a central tank to less than 10 customers. The existing definition of "gas company" is broad in scope and may be read to include all dealers of gas in any form. With the exception of one large central tank facility, the commission has not exercised its jurisdiction over dealers of gas in individual containers or from central tanks. Economic regulation of such dealers is not necessary and effective safety regulation would require a substantial increase in the commission's budget.
