18 Existing Buildings within 33 feet of the

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 23 MRSA §1401, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

24 4. Provision waived. The commissioner may, if  
25 it is determined that necessity requires the con-  
26 struction of a building in the exact location of an  
27 existing building, waive the provision of subsection  
28 2.

29 STATEMENT OF FACT

30 There have been instances when it has been neces-  
31 sary to construct a building in the exact location of

1 an existing building. The purpose of this bill is to  
2 allow some discretion in the application of the  
3 33-foot provision of Title 23, section 1401.

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
