17 AN ACT Concerning State Assistance to  
18 Areas Affected by Indo-chinese Immigrants.  
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. Educational programs available to  
23 Indo-chinese; investigation. The Department of Edu-  
24 cational and Cultural Services shall investigate and  
25 study the educational programs available to  
26 Indo-chinese within the State, and methods of provid-  
27 ing assistance to areas of the State, which have  
28 large numbers of Indo-chinese people living within  
29 those areas.

30 Sec. 2. Report. The department shall complete  
31 the study and report its findings and recommendations  
32 and any necessary implementing legislation on or  
33 before January 4, 1984, to the Second Regular Session  
34 of the 11th Legislature. This report shall address  
35 the matters set out in this Act and shall include

1 proposed legislation in proper draft form to effectu-  
2 ate such course of action as the department may  
3 recommend in that report.

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 The purpose of this bill is to require the  
6 Department of Educational and Cultural Services to  
7 investigate educational programs available to  
8 Indo-chinese within the State and to recommend  
9 methods for assisting areas with large numbers of  
10 Indo-chinese immigrants.
