**AN ACT Making Additional Appropriations,
Authorizations and Allocations Relating to
Federal Block Grants for the Expenditures
of State Government for the Fiscal Year
Ending June 30, 1983.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Federal Government has changed its method of distributing certain funds from categorical grants to block grants effective October 1, 1981; and

Whereas, the First Regular Session of the 110th Legislature enacted legislation requiring legislative

1 approval prior to the state implementation of federal
2 block grants; and

3 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci-
4 dent to the operation of state departments and insti-
5 tutions will become due and payable before July 1,
6 1983; and

7 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
8 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
9 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
10 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
11 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
12 therefore,

13 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
14 follows:

15 Sec. 1. Appropriations from General Fund. In
16 order to provide for necessary expenditures of gov-
17 ernment and other purposes for the fiscal year ending
18 June 30, 1983, the following sum or as much thereof
19 as shall be found necessary, as designated in the
20 following tabulation, is appropriated out of any
21 moneys in the General Fund not otherwise appropri-
22 ated.

25 Sec. 4. Additional funds. Any additional funds
26 that might become available due to implementation of
27 block grants and the possible overlapping of other
28 grants shall be carried forward for future allocation
29 by the Legislature or may be used to offset any possible
30 reduction in the block grants, in sections 1
31 and 2.

32 Sec. 5. Salary plan adjustments. Allocations
33 may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget
34 Officer with the approval of the Governor to specifi-
35 cally cover those adjustments determined to be neces-
36 sary under any salary plan approved by the Legis-
