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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 428,

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L.D. 1297, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Laws Relating

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to Fees for Nonresident Concealed Weapons Permit."

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Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 1

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and inserting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2032, sub-§5, as enacted by PL

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1981, c. 119, §2, is amended to read:

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5. Nonresident. Any nonresident who meets the

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requirements of this section shall make an applica-

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tion to the Chief of the State Police and the appli-

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cation, fees and permit provisions of this section

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shall apply, except that a nonresident applicant

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shall submit an application fee not to exceed \$100 in

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the case of an original application and a fee not to

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exceed \$100 in the case of a renewal. The fees re-

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quired under this subsection shall be applied to the

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expense of administering this subsection.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment changes nonresident concealed

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weapons permit fees to \$100 for both original appli-

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cations and renewals. The fees for residents remain

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at current levels because the costs for records

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checks of residents are much lower than for nonresi-

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dents. The nonresident permit fees shall be applied

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to the expense of administering the subsection in

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order to defray the high costs of records checks on

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nonresidents.
