AN ACT to Prohibit smelting on Morrill Pond in Somerset County.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
<pre>Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7552, sub-§5, ¶E, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:</pre>
E. The Kennebec River, downstream from Indian Pond dam in T1 R6, Somerset County to tidewater in Augusta, Kennebec County, shall be open to fly fishing only for all fish with a one fish daily limit from September 15th to October 31st; and

F. The open season in Aroostook County for all fish in rivers, brooks and streams is May 1st to September 15th; and
