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20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7552, sub-§5, ¶E, as enacted by  
23 PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:

24 E. The Kennebec River, downstream from Indian  
25 Pond dam in T1 R6, Somerset County to tidewater  
26 in Augusta, Kennebec County, shall be open to fly  
27 fishing only for all fish with a one fish daily  
28 limit from September 15th to October 31st; and

29 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7552, sub-§5, ¶E, as enacted by  
30 PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is amended to read:

31 F. The open season in Aroostook County for all  
32 fish in rivers, brooks and streams is May 1st to  
33 September 15th; and

1           Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7552, sub-§5, ¶G is enacted to  
2 read:

3           G. There shall be a continued closed season on  
4 the taking of smelts from Morrill Pond in  
5 Somerset County.
