**AN ACT to Remove any Statutory Reference
Mandating Teachers to take 6 Credit Hours
for Recertification.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13001, sub-§4, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §13402, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove all statutory mandates requiring teachers to take 6 credit hours of professional courses in order to receive a renewal of their 5-year teaching certificate.
