SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to
S.P. 439, L.D. 1318, Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to the
Political Rights of State Employees."

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Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part
designated "§21." in subsection 2 in the 5th line
(page 1, line 32 in amendment) by striking out the
underlined letters and word "A, B, D and E" and
inserting in their place the following: "A, B, C, D,
E, G, H and I"

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to remove addi-
tional officers and employees in the unclassified
service from coverage in that part designated section
22 in House Amendment D.

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This amendment allows certain state employees to
run for nonpartisan elective office and allow
nonfederally funded state employees to run for par-
tisan elective office.

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This amendment allows these rights to the follow-
ing groups:

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1. Heads of departments and members of boards
and commissions required by law to be appointed by
the Governor, some bureau directors and the secretary
of the Public Utilities Commission;

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2. Employees working in the Governor's office at
the Blaine Mansion;

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3. Officers and employees of the unorganized
territory school system and the teachers and prin-

1 cipals of the school systems in state vocational
2 schools and state institutions; and

3 4. Deputies, assistants, staff attorneys,
4 research assistants and the secretary to the Attorney
5 General of the Attorney General's Department.

6 Employees excluded under section 21, subsection
7 2, who are employed by an agency or department funded
8 by or in receipt of federal moneys, would be subject
9 to the provisions of Title 5, United States Code,
10 Sections 1501 to 1508, Hatch Act.
