SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1027, L.D. 1328,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Consideration of the Age
of the Victim in Sentencing Criminal Offenders."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of subsection
8 and inserting in its place the following:

'8. To permit sentences which do not diminish
the gravity of offenses, with reference to the
factor, among others, of the age of the victim.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to make a cor-
rection. In its discussion of the new draft, the
Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary voted to elimi-
nate reference to the vulnerability of the victim.
This amendment makes that correction.
