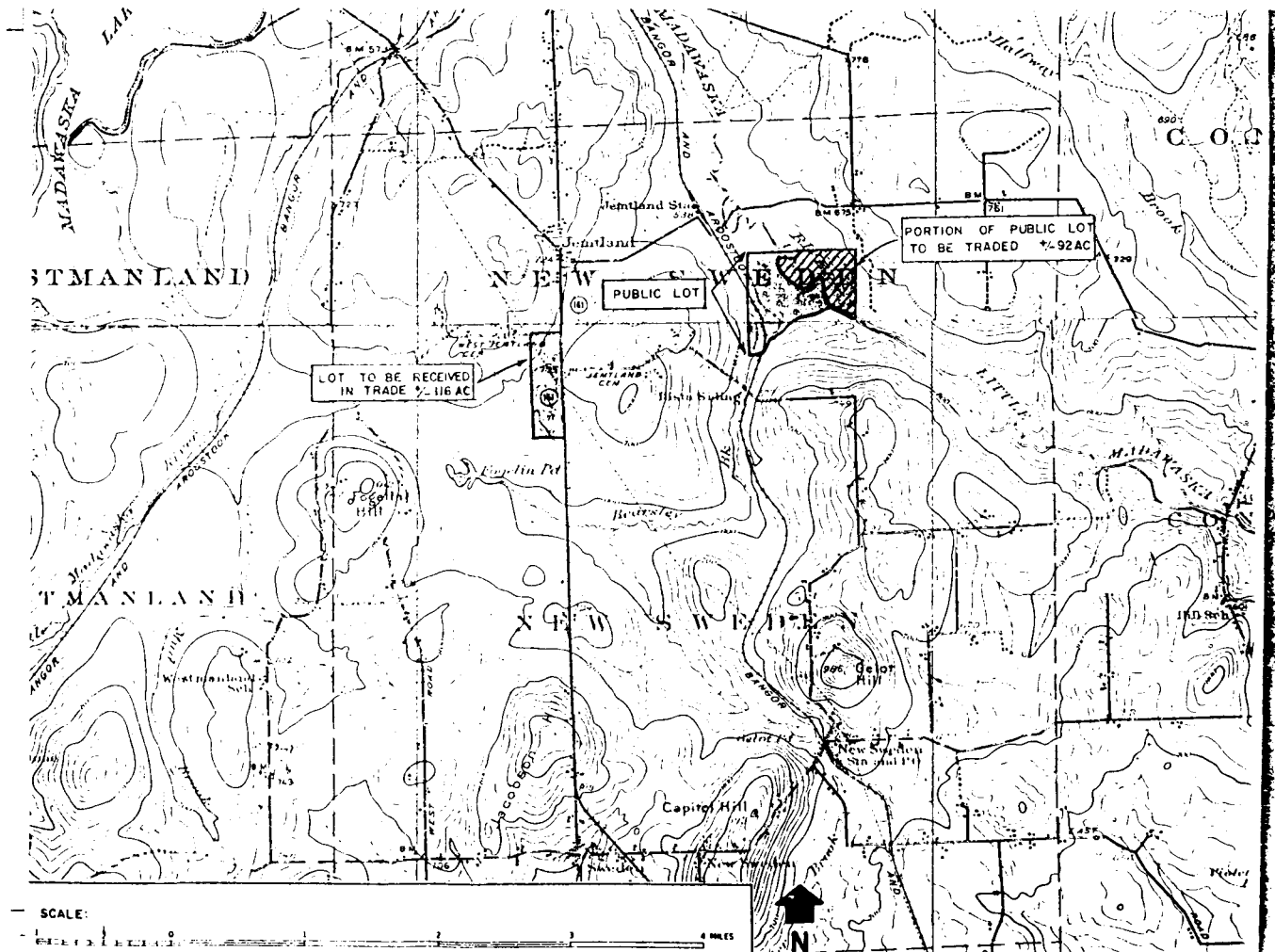

17 RESOLVE, Authorizing the Exchange of  
18 Certain Public Lands.  
19

20 Director of Bureau of Public Lands authorized to  
21 consummate the exchange of certain public, domain,  
22 lands. Resolved: That the Director of the Bureau of  
23 Public Lands is authorized to consummate an exchange  
24 of land in the Town of New Sweden between the State  
25 of Maine and Richard and Gloria Seigars of New Swe-  
26 den. Land received by the State in this trade will  
27 be managed under the authority of Title 12, section  
28 554.

29 In accordance with the provisions of Title 30,  
30 section 4169, there has been public notification of  
31 the proposed exchange. No request for a public meet-  
32 ing has been received.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve authorizes an exchange of 92 acres, more or less, of public domain land in return for 116 acres, more or less, of neighboring land owned by Richard and Gloria Seigars, as indicated on the attached map. The purpose of the exchange is to resolve problems of access associated with that portion of the public domain parcel located on the northeast side of the Little Madawaska River. Attempts to negotiate a right-of-way from existing transportation routes across abutting private property to the public domain parcel have not been successful.

The trade parcel to be received by the State is forested, suitable for management and located along a major travel route. The Board of Selectmen, Town of New Sweden, expressed its approval of the proposed exchange in a letter to the bureau, dated September 20, 1982.
